Dear Friend:

I have set up a preliminary departure date for our 2008 medical mission to Nigeria. I would like to leave on Saturday, March 15th and return on Sunday, March 30th.

The entire team would embark from Atlanta, GA at 4:40 PM on March 15th, and the flight with DELTA is non-stop to Lagos. We would have to board a Nigerian flight to Abuja upon our arrival in Lagos, but it is still better than traveling through Europe with the other airlines.



The cost of the flight from Atlanta to Lagos is \$1,484. You would have to find your own way to Atlanta where the team will depart from. There will be an extra charge per participant to cover inter-country expenses (travel, rooms, food, flight) and to purchase additional instruments and supplies we will need to carry out our work there. This is very inexpensive when you consider that we will be 2 weeks there.

Hospitals in developing Third World countries like Nigeria are hampered by inadequate supplies and lack of medicines and equipment to perform even the simple task such as taking a blood glucose reading. We are going to serve in a small way, but in many cases the results can be huge. We have already shipped over to Nigeria 2 used EKG machines, and a small supply of glucose meters, strips, vitamins, drugs, homeopathy products for HIV, and other ancillary products.

I hope to centralize the team at JUTH, in Jos, Plateau State. We will transport smaller teams as needed to Bauchi, Lafia, Gusau, and possibly other hospitals in other cities. It may depend on the number of medical volunteers we get this year. We are certainly open to any suggestions you have for undertaking specialty projects while you are there. Other areas other than diabetes could include hypertension, HIV, malaria, nutrition, infectious disease, etc., please let me know.

As you enjoy your time with family and friends in our most fortunate country, I would appreciate if you would consider making this humanitarian commitment to the gentle people of Nigeria. This is a wonderful program - professionally, emotionally, and spiritually fulfilling!
